# What is differentiated traffic?

Since 15 January 2020, **in the case of a pollution peak** in Geneva, the most polluting vehicles are not allowed to travel in the centre of the canton between **06.00 and 22.00**:

- the differentiated traffic **zone** in the event of smog covers the centre of the canton (excluding the motorway),
- only vehicles with a sticker permitted during the pollution peak can travel within this zone (the French CRIT'Air sticker is also valid).
