- ✓ To view all the fields to be filled in the online registration form before registering.


To start your online registration

Step 1

Go to the website www.ge.ch/en/getting-vaccinated-against-covid-19

Select « **Click here to access online registration platform** » (Choose EN-English)

Once you are on the page, click « **Start the registration** »

Then click or press "continue".





Step 5

You will have the possibility once you have your appointments allocated to change them if necessary.

Step 6

Select the contact mode, then click or press "next".


Step 8

You will receive a first SMS containing a verification code (6 digit number).

NOTE: *This first SMS with a 6 digit code is not your final registration number for the vaccination. You have not completed the registration process.*



You must proceed to confirm your registration by entering this number in your registration form, in the window that appears on the registration platform screen. Then you will have to click or press "verify".




In order to finalise your registration, please enter the code received by SMS to the mobile number you have indicated.

Step 9

You will receive a second SMS confirming your registration. You are now on the waiting list. As soon as possible, you will receive another SMS with your appointment (place, day and time for dose 1 and dose 2.)



Step 10

Once registered, you can change or cancel your appointment at any time:

- **To change your vaccination centre:** call 0800 909 400
- **To change the date or time of your appointment:** select and click on the link [https//](https://ge.covid-vaccin.ch/vaccinations/4843_b250f4df1a77) received by SMS or call the vaccination centre directly.
